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**Constitution of Departmental Research Advisory Committee (DRAC):**

There shall be a Departmental Research Advisory Committee (DRAC), for each Department consisting of following members:-

- i) Guide/s of the concerned department (Senior shall be Chairman)
- ii) Two outside members having same qualification as that of guide and from the same department concerned to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor from the panel of experts provided by the guide.

**Functions of Departmental Research Advisory Committee (DRAC):**

The DRAC shall perform the following duties:-

- i) To review the research proposal and finalize the topic of research.
- ii) To guide the research scholar to develop the study design and methodology of research and identify the course(s) that he/she may have to do.

**Tenure of the DRAC** shall be Two years from the date of its first meeting.
