1. INTRODUCTION:

The Govt. of Haryana has established the first **AYUSH University** in the holy City, Kurukshetra - The land of Bhagwad Geeta. This is the first University related to Indian systems of medicine in the State as well as in India and all over the world. It was established by the Shri Krishna AYUSH University Act no. 25 of 2017 vide Gazette Notification No. Legislature 27/2017 dated 25/09/2017 for the purpose of teaching, affiliating and ensuring proper and systematic Instructions, Training & Research in Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy System of Medicine, aiming to achieve excellence in these fields.

Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra is committed to promote research in the field of Indian System of Medicine & Allied Sciences. The Degree of **Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D. (Ayurveda)}** is the doctorate degree awarded by the University for original contribution to knowledge.

The Ph.D. (Ayurveda) degree will be awarded to a candidate, who, as per these regulations, has submitted a dissertation based on original research work done by him / her in any particular discipline or interdiscipline, contributing to the advancement of knowledge or to innovative methods of application of existing knowledge, so as to contribute to the betterment of lives of the people and has got the dissertation approved by designated examiners.

The University intends to provide Ph.D (Ayurveda) in various departments/subjects depending upon the availability of seats.

2. Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra, is authorized to conduct the Research Entrance Test (RET) and counseling for admission to Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D. (Ayurveda)} course, subject to verification of eligibility and original documents by the Admission Committee constituted by the Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.

3. The Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D. (Ayurveda)} Courses is available in Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra. The counseling/ admission process will be done in phase wise manner as under –

Phase-I:

Direct admission of in-service candidates of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra, a constituent college of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra, will be done. Admission prospectus along with the

application form shall be uploaded on the university website (www.skau.ac.in). Preference will be given to candidates of concerned subject. Guides of allied subjects will be provided to the subjects in which guide of concern subject is not available. In-service candidates of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College Kurukshetra, a constituent college of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra, will be exempted from Research Entrance Test but shall have to fill prescribed form on the website of university along with prescribed fees and NOC from the Employer.

Phase-II:

After Phase-I admissions, the remaining seats will be published on the university website and the application form shall be called from external candidates and the admission procedure will be followed for Research Entrance Test. 50% of the seats shall be filled from All India Category (AIQ) and 50% from Haryana State Quota (HSQ). HSQ seats will be filled as per Haryana State reservation policy. Any seat remaining vacant in AIQ shall be filled from HSQ and visa versa. 5% seats of the State Quota seats shall be filled up by person with benchmark disabilities in accordance with the guidelines regarding admission to students with specified Disabilities under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016 as per roaster decided by the University from time to time. The Disability Certificate issued by designated Disability Centers notified in Information Bulletin of NEET-2020 (**Annexure-I**) and the Medical Board constituted by PGIMS, Rohtak will only be considered valid for counseling/admission purpose for the academic session Jan. 2021. The dates on which the Medical board at PGIMS Rohtak will sit shall be duly publicized on the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra (www.skau.ac.in).

Note: Guide of allied subjects is only allowed for in-service candidates of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra.

- Distribution of seats is subject to applicability of state reservation policy for higher education as notified by the State Government from time to time.
- The State Reservation Policy shall be applicable for admission to all State Quota Seats in Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.

4. It is further notified that all the students desirous of seeking admission to Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D (Ayurveda)} Courses will have to get registered online on the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra i.e. www.skau.ac.in.

The candidates are required to regularly visit the website as stated above for updates.

5. Eligibility Criteria:

A candidate for admission to Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D (Ayurveda)} Courses in Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra will be eligible if he/she:

- is a citizen of India.
- A candidate having Post Graduate Degree in Ayurveda {MD/ MS (Ayurveda)} in concerned subject from a recognized Institute.
- Teaching Staff (having P.G. degree) of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College/ Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.

OR

Candidates passed Research Entrance Test (RET) conducted by Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.

OR

Candidates passed AYUSH-NET.

- iv. Bonafide resident of Haryana (for state quota seats), as per instructions issued by the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana and who/whose parents produce Haryana Bonafide Residence Certificate as per Govt. instructions or any modification issued by competent authority from time to time.
- v. Candidates who have obtained their degree/s through correspondence course/s are not eligible.

6. A candidate who is already admitted to any Courses including Ph.D in any Institution is not eligible for admission till the completion of the course. An undertaking to this effect shall be given by the candidate. Concealment of facts would invite disqualification without assigning any reason.

7. Procedure for Admission to Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D (Ayurveda)} courses in Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra (Haryana)

The admission to the Ph. D. (Ayurveda) Programme shall be either through direct admission of in-service candidates of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra or candidates passed through Research Entrance Test (RET) conducted by the Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra or candidates passed AYUSH NET. The application form shall be the same for all types of candidates. The candidates who are eligible for direct admission shall indicate in the form that they are exempted from RET.

The admission for session Jan, 2021 shall be conducted in two phases:

Phase-I:

- i) For in-service candidates of Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra.
- ii) The application form along with requisite fee and documents shall be filled and uploaded on the university website (www.skau.ac.in).
- iii) NOC from the Head of Institute (**Annexure II**) concerned shall be mandatory.
- iv) The University will declare the result by publishing the common merit list on its official website. i.e www.skau.ac.in

- v) The candidates who have been provisionally allocated seat will have to appear in person for document verification and interview (with all original documents and two sets of self-attested Photostat copies) before the admission committee at Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.
- vi) After document verification and interview, qualified candidates will have to submit Ph.D. (Ayurveda) registration form along with registration fees as prescribed by university.
- vii) The process of admission completes only when a selected candidate has deposited the prescribed fees for Ph.D. (Ayurveda) registration.
- viii) After submission and verification of all eligibility documents and payment of the prescribed fees by the due date, the provisional admission would be confirmed by office of Dean Academic Affairs.

Phase-II:

- i) After Phase-I admissions, the remaining seats will be published on the university website (www.skau.ac.in). The application form shall be called from external candidates and AYUSH NET qualified candidates. Candidates who have qualified AYUSH NET shall be exempted from the entrance examination during the period of validity of the concerned test.

The admission procedure will be followed for Research Entrance Test.

- ii) The application form can be filled and uploaded on University website (www.skau.ac.in) and shall be accompanied by prescribed fees along with the relevant certificates.
- iii) Incomplete application received by the university shall be rejected and no correspondence shall be entertained by the University.
- iv) The University shall organize an online Research Entrance Test (RET) for the purpose of admission to Ayurveda Vidyavaridhi {Ph.D. (Ayurveda)} Programme for all the regular Full time as well as Part time Ph.D (Ayurveda) candidates.
- v) The Entrance Test shall consist of two papers and personal interview as viva voce on research proposal.

Paper – I: Research Methodology & General Aptitude – 50 Marks (1 Hour)

Paper – II: Subject knowledge test (based on post graduate specialization) – 50 Marks
(1 Hour)

Personal interview/ Viva voice on research proposal – 50 marks

Total - 150 marks

The entrance test for the Ph.D. (Ayurveda) programme shall be of multiple choice Questions for 100 marks and of 2 hours duration. The candidate will also have to give a presentation on the proposed research topic and Personal interview. The minimum passing marks for the entrance test, presentation and personal interview is 50% for general and 45% for reserved category.

- vi) NOC from the Head of Institute (Annexure II) concerned shall be mandatory.
- vii) The University will publish the common merit list within 30 days of Ph.D. (Ayurveda) RET on its official website (www.skau.ac.in)
- viii) After declaration of RET result, the qualified candidates will be allocated provisional seats online. The provisional allocation of the seat online shall give no legal right to the candidate for the said seat and the seat shall be confirmed only after document verification as per the specific time period notified. The Admission Committee reserves the right to cancel the provisional allocation of seat allotted to a candidate in case of incomplete/ invalid documents.
- ix) The candidates who have been provisionally allocated seat will have to appear in person for document verification (with all original documents and two sets of self-attested Photostat copies) before the admission committee at Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra.
- x) After document verification qualified candidates will have to submit Ph.D. (Ayurveda) registration form along with registration fees as prescribed by university.
- xi) The process of admission completes only when a selected candidate has deposited the prescribed fees for Ph.D. (Ayurveda) registration.
- xii) After submission and verification of all eligibility documents and payment of the prescribed fee by the due date, the provisional admission would be confirmed by office of Dean Academic Affairs.
- xiii) If the candidate fails to submit his/ her joining report and prescribed fee within prescribed period by the University it will be assumed that the candidate is not interested in the Ph.D. (Ayurveda) registration. Ph.D. (Ayurveda) Registration deemed to be considered as cancelled. Communication in this regard shall be issued by the Head of the Institution and with information to the university.

- xiv) The allocation of Research Guide for a selected research scholar shall be decided by the University depending on the number of scholars per Research Guide, the available specialization among the Research Guide and research interests of the scholars as indicated by them at the time of interview / viva voce.
- xv) The Admission Committee will be responsible for taking decision for admission related matters like-supervision of admission & conduct of counseling, document verification, allocation of seats etc. in accordance with existing rules and regulation. Further, the admission Committee is empowered to take decision in all admission related disputes.

Note:

- I. The Registrar, Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra, will be the final Appellate Authority in all admissions related disputes and his decision shall be the final.
- II. Final number of seats in each course/specialty will be available on the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra (www.skau.ac.in).

8. Duration of Course:

- (1) Ph.D. (Ayurveda) Programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including Course work. If a candidate fails to submit Dissertation at the end of stipulated time, he/ she may grant an extension of upto 2 years (One year at a time) for the submission of Dissertation. If a candidate fails to submit the Dissertation within the extended period he/ she may be given additional one year extension for submitting the Dissertation thus the total period for submission of Dissertation counted from the date of his/ her admission does not exceed six years. The actual term of selected Ph.D. (Ayurveda) scholar shall be deemed to start from the date of provisional registration.
- (2) Normally, a candidate shall be required to complete his research under the direct supervision of his guide or Supervisor. However, a candidate who is a full time teacher or the person in-service shall be permitted to complete the research work at his college or place of his duty or appointment. In such condition, it shall be mandatory for such teacher candidate or person in Government / Private service to work at least 90 days in the full tenure of the Ph.D. (Ayurveda) course, by way of

leave / vacation / deputation, etc. under direct supervision of his guide or Supervisor before submission of the final dissertation. The certificate from the guide or Supervisor regarding mandatory attendance of the Ph.D. (Ayurveda) scholar, shall be pre-condition for submission of final dissertation through the Institution/ Department/ College.

9. Fee Structure:

Extension fees to be added as of Rs. 10,000/- for 1st year, Rs 20,000/- for 2nd year and 30,000/- for 3rd year of extension apart from Rs 50,000/- per year of annual tuition fees. Change in fee structure may be amended by University from time to time.

The fees shall be payable on annual basis and the university shall not ask the candidates to deposit fees for the entire course in advance.

10. General Instructions:-

- a. List of original documents to be brought at the time of Counseling is at **Annexure-III**. No attested copies of certificates will be accepted.
- b. Admitted students shall pay the fees and other charges for all types of seats as per the fixed fee and other charges fixed by Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra from time to time.
- c. All candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes/EWS/PWD/ESM/FF etc. must submit a certificate in the prescribed format issued from the competent authority of the State Government.
- d. All candidates belonging to **Scheduled caste and Backward Classes** etc. must submit a valid certificate from the competent authority in the format as prescribed by Haryana Govt. (**Annexure IV & V**).

- e. The admission to Backward Classes will be as per instructions laid in Notification dated 28.08.2018 issued by Welfare of Schedule Caste and Backward Classes Department (**Annexure-VI**). The certificates must be issued by the competent authority of the State Government as defined in the Notification dated 18/11/2016 (**Annexure-VII**) issued by Welfare of Schedule Caste and Backward Classes Department.
- f. The candidate of BC-A & BC-B will be required to submit an income certificate (Current year) (**Annexure-VIII**) issued by the competent authority of the Revenue Department like Tehsildar of the State Government.
- g. The Children of persons of Backward Class having gross annual income upto 6 lakh rupees will get benefits of reservation in-services and admission to educational institutions. The sections of Backward class above 6 lakh rupees per annum shall be considered as creamy layer under section 5 of Haryana backward class (Reservation in-services and admission in Educational Institution Act, 2016, 15 of 2016).
- h. If the seats from BC-A are not filled up, these may be filled from BC-B & Vice Versa.
- i. Further, 3% reservation is also provided to Ex-serviceman/ Freedom Fighter and their dependents by providing reservation within reservation of 1% of General Category, 1% out of Scheduled Caste and 1% from Backward Classes category for admission to the various educational institutions of the Govt. and Govt. aided / Institutes located in Haryana. As far as Block allocation in Block-A and Block-B of Backward Classes category is concerned year wise rotational system will be adopted. For example if Block-A of Backward Classes are given seats in academic year 2014, the next Block i.e. (B) Block of Category of Backward Classes will be given seats in the next academic year 2015 and so on.
- j. Only Dependents of Freedom Fighters (FF) who wish to be considered for reservation as such must submit a certificate from the Competent Authority along with undertaking (**Annexure-IX**).
- k. The reservation to Ex-servicemen and their wards will be considered as per notification of State Government Notification No. 22/10/2013-1 GS-III dated 10.08.2017 (**Annexure-X**).
- l. Reservation for EWS Category shall be provided as per Haryana Government Notification dated 25.02.2019 (**Annexure-XI**). The candidates will be required to

- submit Income and Asset/Income Disclosure Certificate issued from Competent Authority as per (**Annexure-XII**) of the said Notification dated 25.02.2019.
- m. Roster for all categories of seats including PWD, EWS shall be maintained by Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra for allotment of seats under reserved category.
- n. A candidate from reserved category shall have the right to compete for admission in General/Unreserved category seats as per his/her merit. In case a candidate does not fill up his/ her reserve category in his/ her application form, he/she will not be subsequently considered for admission against that category.
- A candidate belongs to more than one reserved category, he/she shall be required to give his/her preference at the time of filling up the admission form. Preference once given shall not be changed. A candidate who qualifies for admission in more than one reserved category will be given as per reservation rules at the time of counseling.
- However, if a reserved category candidate has availed of any concession, such as relaxation in upper age limit, qualification or permitted number of chances in written examination etc., then he/she cannot be considered against General/ Un-reserved seats.
- o. Duly signed and scanned declaration form as **Annexure XIII** is mandatory to be uploaded on the website along with the application form.
- p. NOC from the institute attached as **Annexure II** is mandatory to be uploaded on the website along with the application form.
- q. The Vice-Chancellor of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra will be competent to issue any corrigendum/ addendum if needed on the recommendation of Draft Counseling Committee /Admission Committee.

****Note – in view of the situation arisen because of Pandemic COVID-19, the schedule of admission including document verification may be altered. The changes, if any shall be duly publicized as well as uploaded on the admission web portal as well as website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra i.e. www.skau.ac.in and the candidates are required to regularly visit the websites as stated above for updates.***

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your kind attention to the Government instructions issued vide letter of even number dated 1 5.07 .2014 on the subject noted above.

It is intimated that Government of India, Ministry of Defence, Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare D (Res-II) has intimated that vide letter number 6(l) 12017-D (Res-II) dated lg.05.2107, the following priorities for reservations or preferences to the wards of Armed Forces personnel should be applied by States/ UTs/Central/ State Universities/Autonomous Institutions for admission in medical/professional/non-professional courses : -

- Priority-I: Widows/ Wards of Defence personnel killed in action.
Priority-II: Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service
Priority-III: Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who dies while in with death attributable to military service.
Priority-IV: Wards of disabled in service and boarded out with disability attributable to Military service.
Priority-V: Wards of Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards:
i. ParamVir Chakra
ii. Ashok Chakra
iii. SarvottamYudhSeva Medal
iv. MahaVir Chakra
v. Kirti Chakra
vi. UttamYudh Seva Medal
vii. Vir Chakra
viii. Shaurya Chakra
ix. YudhSeva Medal
x. Sena, NauSena, VayuSena Medal
xi. Mention-in-Despatches
Priority-VI: Wards of Ex-servicemen,
Priority-VII: Wards of Serving Personnel.

The State Government has decided to adopt the above provision made by Government of India in their letter dated 19.05.2017 with the following amendments:

- 2.1 In Priority V, the words "and serving personnel" are removed.
- 2.2 The priority VII is altogether deleted.

Therefore, Para 5 of General Administration Department instructions even number dated 15.07, 2014 is amended to this extent.

Subject:- Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in Direct recruitment in Civil posts and services as well as in admissions in Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions in the State of Haryana.

I am directed to inform that government of India has notified "THE CONSTITUTION (ONE HUNDRED AND THIRD AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019" On 12th January, 2019 amending Article 15 & 16, which are now read as under:-

Amendment of article 15

In Article 15 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted namely:-

'(6) Nothing in this article or sub-clauses (g) of clause(1) of article 19 or clause (2) of article 29 shall prevent the State from making,-

- a). Any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5); and
- b). Any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5); in so far as such special provisions relate to their admission to educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or unaided by the State, other than the minority educational institutions referred to in clause(1) of article 30, which in the case of reservation would be in addition to the existing reservations and subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category.

Explanation- For the purposes of this article and article 16, “economically weaker sections” shall be such as may be notified by the State from time to time on the basis of family income and other indicators of economic disadvantage.’

Amendment of article 16

In Article 16 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

“(6) Nothing in this article shall prevent the State from making any provision for the reservation of appointment or posts in favour of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clause (4), in addition to the existing reservation and subject to a maximum of ten cent of the posts in each category”.

In the wake of above enabling provisions, State Government has considered the matter and decided to provide benefits of reservation on a preferential basis in Civil Posts in all the Departments/Boards/Corporations/Local Bodies and in Admissions to Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions to those Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B).

2. QUANTUM OF RESERVATION:

The persons belong to EWSs who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for scheduled Castes, Backward Classes (Block – A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) shall get 10% reservation in direct recruitment to Group A,B,C and D posts in the Departments/Boards/Corporations/Local Bodies of Government of Haryana and also in admission to Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions in the State of Haryana.

3. EFFECTING RESERVATION-ROSTER POINT:

3.1 Direct recruitment in case of Group-A & B

Roster point No. 11-20-30-40-51-60-70-80-90 and 99

3.2 Direct recruitment in case of Group-C & D

Roster point No. 4-14-24-34-43-53-66-76-82 and 94

3.3 Where in any recruitment year any vacancy earmarked for EWS cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies for that particular recruitment year shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog and will be filled from unreserved category.

3.4 Persons belonging to EWS selected against the quota for persons with benchmark disabilities/ex-servicemen shall be placed against the roster points earmarked for EWS.

4. CRITERIA OF INCOME & ASSETS:

4.1 Persons who are not covered under the exiting scheme of reservation for Scheduled Caste, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 6.00 lakh (Rupees six lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

4.2 Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:-

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- v. Total immovable assets owned are valued at Rs. One Crore or more.

4.3 The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

4.4 The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who applies for benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse as well as children and siblings below the age of 18 years.

5. **INCOME AND ASSET CERTIFICATE ISSUING AUTHORITY AND VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATE:**

5.1 The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent Authority. The competent Authority for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be Tehsildar of the area where the applicant normally resides.

5.2 The prescribed format for EWS income and Asset Certificate shall be as provided at Annexure-I.

5.3 The Officer who issues the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the State.

5.4 The crucial date for submitting Income and Asset Certificate by the candidate may be treated as the closing date for receipt of application for the post, except in cases where crucial date is fixed otherwise.

5.5 The appointing authorities should, in the offer of appointment to the candidates claiming to be belonging to EWS, include the following clause:-

"The appointment is provisional and is subject to the income and asset certificate being verified through the proper channels and if the verification reveals that the claim to belong to EWS is fake/false the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons and provisions of the Indian Penal Code for production of fake/false certificate."

The appointing authority should verify the veracity of the Income and asset certificate submitted by the candidate through the certificate issuing authority.

5.6 Instructions referred to above should be strictly followed so that it may not be possible for an unscrupulous person to secure employment on the basis of a false claim and if any person gets an appointment on the basis of such false claim, her/his services shall be terminated and penal action shall also be invoked.

6. **ADJUSTMENT AGAINST UNRESERVED VACANCIES:**

A person belonging to EWS cannot be denied the right to compete for appointment against an unreserved vacancy. Persons belonging to EWS who are selected on the basis of merit and not on account of reservation are not to be counted towards the quota meant for reservation.

7. The above scheme of reservation will be effective in respect of all direct recruitment vacancies to be notified on or after 01.02.2019.
