TERMS & CONDITION FOR 3RD/MOP-UP ROUND OF UG (BAMS/BHMS) COURSES COUNSELLING FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2021-2022

- 1. If the seats still remain vacant even after the two rounds of counselling then left over seats will be filled up via Mop-Up Round as per direction of Ministry of Ayush, Government of India/NCISM/State Government and as per SKAU, Kurukshetra notified Schedule.
- 2. The candidates who join the seat allotted to them during the first or second round of All India Counselling/State Counselling shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop-up Round.
- 3. Candidate should attain age of 17 years on or before 31.12.2021.
- 4. Benefit of reservation in Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College, Kurukshetra & Maru Singh Memorial Institute of Ayurveda, Khanpur Kalan will be given to all the reserved categories upto 3rd/ Mop-up round counselling according to the Haryana State reservation policy. In case at the time of 3rd counselling the reserved seats of various categories remain vacant and no eligible candidates of the reserved categories are available then these vacant seats may be thrown open to Haryana Open General Category after making proper conversion.
- 5. Request for shifting to other institutes would not be allowed.
- 6. However, all the candidates irrespective of the round they **have registered and not been allotted/not joined/left the seat after joining** and wish to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up Round of online counselling, shall have to submit a declaration, fill the preference/choices and pay the security fees after login to the counselling portal for participating the 3rd/Mopup Round of online counselling (at the given link https://skau.online-counselling.co.in/) for the College/ Course in which they wish seek the admission.
- 7. No candidates would be allowed to participate in 3rd/Mop-up round counselling if he/she has already taken admission in any other institute under this University counselling/ All India Counselling. If such candidates want to participate in 3rd/mop-up round counselling then he/she would have to get his/her admission cancelled (with documentary proof) before participating in mop up round counselling, their Security Fees submitted to the University shall stand forfeited. However, the candidates who wish to participate in the Mop-up round of counselling will have to submit their preferences afresh again.
- 8. The candidate who wish to participate in the mop-up round of counselling and want to opt for State Quota Seats in Government/Government aided Ayurvedic Institutes <u>only</u> shall be required to submit Rs.5,000/- {Rs.2,500/- for SC/D-SC/BC/EWS/ PWD/ESM/FF* of the State of Haryana (*if applicable)}, as Security Fee at the time of fresh registration/choice filling for Mop-up round of counselling.

If the candidate wishes to opt for State Quota seats in <u>Government as well as/or State</u> <u>Quota Seats/ Management Quota seats</u> in Private BAMS/BHMS Institutes/ Universities then He/she will have to deposit Rs.50,000/-, as Security Fee at the time of fresh registration/choice filling for Mop-up round of counselling.

If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount of security fees then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the mop-up round of counselling.

This amount shall be later **ADJUSTED** in the fee of first year course, if the candidate joins the allotted seat; The Security money will be **FORFEITED**, if a candidate who has been allotted a seat and does not join the respective institution or surrender the seat due to any unforeseen reason before and after joining. Also the Security Money will be forfeited, if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason on the part of student. i.e. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within the stipulated time) and **REFUNDED** (after following the process of refund) in case no seat is allotted.

- 9. The candidates will have to deposit the tuition fee online through his/her dashboard to the Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra at the time of joining, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
- 10. The **personal appearance** of the candidates at the time of joining and **document verification** at the concerned allotted college is mandatory.
- 11. Any order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court/Punjab and Haryana High Court/ Amendments by the State Government/India Government/ Ministry of AYUSH, GOI/NCISM (CCIM) shall be applicable at any stage.
- 12. All documents must be produced in original, documents like Matriculation (10th), Senior Secondary (10+2), Character certificate issued by the last attended college/institute, Haryana Resident Domicile, NEET-2021 Score Card, Benchmark Disability, Proof of Identification, Caste Certificate or any other relevant document/certificate as per notification alongwith two sets of self-attested photocopies and four photographs. In case the students already deposited the original documents in any other institute/college then, he/she have to produce the receipt of that institute/college regarding documents with an undertaking to submit the original document within a stipulated time as decided by the concerned allotted college.
- 13. For PwD seat candidate has to produce **relevant certificate** of Benchmark disability issued by appropriate institution mentioned in **Annexure-VI of notification**.
- 14. Candidate has to submit an undertaking in the form of **affidavit** that he/she is not pursuing UG (BAMS/BHMS) course in any institute, anywhere in India.
- a) If any discrepancy/false statement in the documents of the candidate found therein subsequently at any stage, his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
 b) If any dispute/issue arises, in this regard the decision of the concerned college admission committee shall be final in consensus with the UG (BAMS/BHMS) Admission Committee 2021-22 notified by the State vide notification dated 30.12.2021.
- 16. Any kind of grievance will be entertained only by raising a ticket on the admission portal or by submitting grievance through email <u>gr.skau.hry@gmail.com</u>.
- 17. College concerned will constitute a **document verification committee** which will verify all the document of the student with their sole responsibility.
- 18. In future, if any discrepancy or report of fake document is received in that **case student and college will be responsible for cancellation of admission**. The fee will be forfeited and seat will remain vacant.
- 19. Any admission made by any private BAMS/BHMS college/institute those under private university in the state at its own level shall not be valid and such admission shall be considered null and void.
- 20. If any dispute/issue arise, the decision of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra shall be final.
