TERMS & CONDITION FOR 4TH / MOP-UP ROUND / STRAY VACANCY ROUND OF UG BAMS COURSES COUNSELLING FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-2024

1. If the seats still remain vacant even after the three rounds of counselling, then left over seats will be filled up via Mop-Up Round as per direction of Ministry of Ayush, Government of India/NCISM/State Government and as per SKAU, Kurukshetra notified Schedule.
2. The candidates who join the seat allotted to them during the previous round of All India Counselling/State Counselling shall not be eligible to participate in this round.
3. The **personal appearance** of the candidates at the time of joining and **document verification** at the concerned allotted college is mandatory.
4. Any order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court/Punjab and Haryana High Court/ Amendments by the State Government/India Government/Ministry of AYUSH, GOI/NCISM (CCIM) shall be applicable at any stage.
5. **Eligibility Criteria** for BAMS Degree courses will be as per Information Bulletin of NEET (UG) – 2023.
6. As per Information Bulletin of NEET (UG) – 2023, no candidate shall be admitted to BAMS, BSMS, BUMS & BHMS Degree courses unless he has **attained the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year** of his admission in the first year of the course and The NCISM (vide letter dated 15.07.2022) and NCH (vide letter dated 15.07.2022) have jointly decided not to insist any upper age limit for candidates seeking admission in ASU & H (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS/BHMS) undergraduate courses for the academic year **2023-24, i.e. there is no upper age limit for admission in ASU & H-UG courses.**
7. Fresh registration shall be allowed for participating in the round. Fresh candidates will have to register themselves on the admission web portal (at the given link <https://skau.online-counselling.co.in/>). The candidates will have to **deposit the fee online** (at the given link <https://skau.online-counselling.co.in/> to the Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra at the time of joining, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
8. Benefit of reservation in all participating colleges / institutions will be given to all the reserved categories upto this round of counselling according to the Haryana State reservation policy. In case at the time of allotment, the reserved seats of various categories remain vacant and no eligible candidates of the reserved categories are available, **then these vacant seats may be offered to others after making proper conversion as per notification.**
9. **Request for shifting to other institutes would not be allowed.**
10. However, all the candidates irrespective of the round they **have registered and not been allotted/not joined/left the seat after joining** and wish to participate in this Round of online counselling, shall have to submit a declaration, fill the preference/choices and pay the security fees after login to the counselling portal for participating the this Round of online counselling (at the given link <https://skau.online-counselling.co.in/>) for the College/ Course in which they wish seek the admission.
11. **No candidates would be allowed to participate in this round of counselling if he/she has already taken admission in any other institute under this University counselling/ All India Counselling. If such candidates want to participate in this round of counselling, then he/she would have to get his/her admission cancelled (with documentary proof) before participating in mop up round counselling, their Security Fees submitted to the University shall stand forfeited. However, the candidates who wish to participate in the Mop-up round of counselling will have to submit their preferences afresh again.**
12. The candidate who wish to participate in this round of counselling and want to opt for State Quota Seats in Government/Government aided Ayurvedic Institutes **only** shall be required to submit Rs.5,000/- {Rs.2,500/- for SC/D-SC/BC/EWS/ PWD/ESM/FF* of the State of Haryana (*if applicable)}, as Security Fee at the time of fresh registration/choice filling for Mop-up round of counselling. If the candidate wishes to opt for State Quota seats in **Government as well as/or State Quota Seats/ Management Quota seats** in Private BAMS Institutes/ Universities then He/she will have to deposit

Rs.50,000/-, as Security Fee at the time of fresh registration/choice filling for Mop-up round of counselling.

If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount of security fees then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the mop-up round of counselling.

This amount shall be later **ADJUSTED** in the fee of first year course, if the candidate joins the allotted seat. The Security money will be **FORFEITED**, if a candidate who has been allotted a seat and does not join the respective institution or surrender the seat due to any unforeseen reason before and after joining. Also the Security Money will be forfeited, if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason on the part of student. i.e. in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission (within the stipulated time) and **REFUNDED (after following the process of refund)** in case no seat is allotted.

13. The candidates will have to deposit the tuition fee online through his/her dashboard to the Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra at the time of joining, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
14. All documents must be **produced in original**, documents like Matriculation (10th), Senior Secondary (10+2), Character certificate issued by the last attended college/institute, Haryana Resident Domicile, NEET-2023 Score Card, Benchmark Disability, Proof of Identification, Caste Certificate or any other relevant document/certificate as per notification **alongwith two sets of self-attested photocopies and four photographs**. In case the students already deposited the original documents in any other institute/college then, he/she have to produce the receipt of that institute/college regarding documents with an undertaking to submit the original document within a stipulated time as decided by the concerned allotted college.
15. For PwD seat candidate has to produce **relevant certificate** of Benchmark disability issued by appropriate institution mentioned in **Annexure-VI of notification**.
16. Candidate has to submit an undertaking in the form of **affidavit** that he/she is not pursuing UG (BAMS) course in any institute, anywhere in India.
17. a) If any **discrepancy/false statement in the documents** of the candidate found therein subsequently at any stage, his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
b) If any dispute/issue arises, in this regard the decision of the concerned college admission committee shall be final in consensus with the UG Admission Committee – 2023-24 notified by the State vide notification dated 06.09.2023.
18. Any kind of grievance will be entertained only by raising a ticket on the admission portal.
19. College concerned will constitute a **document verification committee** which will verify all the document of the student with their sole responsibility.
20. In future, if any discrepancy or report of fake document is received in that **case student and college will be responsible for cancellation of admission**. The fee will be forfeited and seat will remain vacant.
21. Any admission made by any private BAMS/BHMS college/institute those under private university in the state **at its own level shall not be valid and such admission shall be considered null and void**.
22. **If any dispute/issue arise, the decision of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra shall be final.**
23. **Some of the seats offered in this round are subjected to outcome of Court case all the students are advised to go through the seat matrix before filling of choices and students opting for the seats as created on the Court's order must submit an undertaking at the time of Joining in writing effect that he/she are well aware that his/her allocation/admission is provisional and subject to the final outcome of the that their admission will be subject to the final outcome of writ petition filed by the respective institution/College and other related case(s) in this regard in any other apex court of the India.**
