Subject:- Procedure for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses in Participating College(s) for Academic Session 2022-23.

1.	<p>The Governor of Haryana is pleased to notify the admission procedure in supersession of all the earlier notifications issued in this regard, to be adopted for admission to Post Graduate Courses i.e. MD/MS (Ayurveda) in Participating College(s) for the Academic Session 2022-23, in the state of Haryana.</p>
	<p>Note: The eligibility criteria for admission i.e. marks in qualifying examinations; age; percentile of entrance test, score of entrance test etc. will be applicable/considered as notified by the concerned regulatory/statutory body (e.g. AIAPGET/NCISM).</p>
2.	<p>It is further notified that in Participating College(s) covered under this Notification, 15% of the seats are under All India Merit Category of AIAPGET-2022, counseling for which is conducted by Department of AYUSH Govt. of India/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (here in after called as NCISM) on the basis of All India merit of AIAPGET-2022 and the counseling for remaining 85% of the seats will be conducted by Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra, Haryana on the basis of AIAPGET-2022.</p> <p>25% seats shall be reserved (Institutional preference) for the candidates who have passed BAMS courses from the Institutions located in the State (Haryana/UT Chandigarh) for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) courses under State Quota seats of respective State (Haryana/UT Chandigarh).</p> <p>5% seats of the State Quota seats shall be filled up by person with benchmark disabilities in accordance with the guidelines regarding admission to students with specified Disabilities under the Rights of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016 based on the merit list of AIAPGET-2022 and as per NCISM guidelines issued from time to time. The Disability Certificate issued by designated Disability Centers notified in Information Bulletin of AIAPGET-2022 (Annexure-I) and the Medical Board constituted by PGIMS, Rohtak will only be considered valid for counseling/admission purposed for the academic session 2022-23. The dates on which the Medical board at PGIMS Rohtak will sit shall be duly publicized on the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra (www.skau.ac.in).</p> <p>There shall be 03 (Three) seats reserved for regular in-service (AMO's / Teachers) candidates of Govt. of Haryana. These seats will be filled-in on the basis of merit of AIAPGET-2022. In-service candidate has to produce NOC issued by state Government. In case there is no in-service candidate available, then these seats shall be filled in from Haryana State merit list based on AIAPGET-2022.</p> <p>There shall be 10% seats of all subjects in Govt. Colleges from State Quota Seats reserved on rotation basis for regular in-service (AMO's) candidates of Govt. of Haryana. Roster in this regard will be maintained. These seats will be filled-in on the basis of merit of AIAPGET-2022. In-service candidate has to produce NOC issued by state Government. In case there is no in-service candidate available, then these seats shall be filled in from Haryana State merit list based on AIAPGET-2022.</p> <p>These above mentioned policy of S.No. 2 is for Govt. College only. If any participating college is a Private Institute of Haryana State or UT Chandigarh or of any Deemed/ Private University, then the rules of State Govt. or UT Chandigarh or of Private University will be followed accordingly.</p>
3.	<p>Shri Krishna AYUSH University Kurukshetra, is authorized to conduct the counseling as per Merit of AIAPGET-2022 for admission in Participating College(s) subject to verification of eligibility and original documents by the Admission Committee constituted by the participating college/institute.</p>

4. The MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses are available currently in Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Kurukshetra, subject to the final approval from the NCISM/Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi /State Govt. /Affiliating University. The tentative seat distribution of MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses of participating colleges/institutes (**Shri Krishna Govt. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Kurukshetra** and **Shri Dhanwantry Ayurvedic College, Chandigarh**) for the Academic Session 2022-23 is as under –

a) The tentative seat distribution of MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses in various college(s)/subjects/specialties will be displayed on the website before the commencement of counseling process. The seats in each participating college(s)/subjects/specialty are subject to the final approval from the NCISM/Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi /State Govt. /Affiliating University. Accordingly, the final distribution of seats may vary depending upon the sanction/decision of the Govt. of India/NCISM/State Government/Affiliating University. The conversion and sequence of seat allocation will be as per (**Annexure-II**)

b) Distribution of seats is subject to applicability of State/UT reservation policy for higher education as notified by the State Government from time to time.

c) The State/UT Reservation Policy shall be applicable for admission to all State Quota Seats in participating college(s).
Reservation for EWS Category shall be provided as per Haryana Government Notification dated 25.02.2019 (**Annexure-III**). The candidates will be required to submit Income and Asset/ Income Disclosure Certificate valid for 2022-23 issued from Competent Authority as per (**Annexure-IV**) of the said Notification dated 25.02.2019 subject to the enhancement of above mention existing seats as per Punjab & Haryana High Court order of CWP No. 7283 of 2020 (O & M) dated 06.05.2020.

d) Roster for all categories of seats including PWD, EWS shall be maintained by Participating College(s) which will be verified by Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra for allotment of seats under reserved category.

6. It is further notified that all the students desirous of seeking admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses will have to get registered online through authorized admission web portal. The details of dates for inviting applications and Counseling schedule shall be duly publicized as well as

7.	<p><u>Eligibility Criteria:</u></p> <p>A candidate for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses in participating college(s) will be eligible if he/she:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> is a citizen of India. has passed BAMS examination from the recognized university/institution situated in Haryana as a bonafide resident of Haryana or has passed BAMS examination from any other Ayurvedic College/Institution recognized by the NCISM/Ministry of Ayush, New Delhi and who/whose parent(s) produce(s) a Haryana Resident Certificate as per Government instructions given in Annexure-V, VI, VII (A to E) or any modification issued by competent authority from time to time. All candidates belonging to Scheduled caste, Deprived Scheduled caste and Backward Classes must submit a valid certificate from the competent authority in the format as prescribed by Haryana Govt. (Annexure-VIII & IX). should have completed satisfactorily one year compulsory Rotatory Internship from Institutions recognized by the NCISM/State Govt./Ministry of AYUSH for this purpose by 31.10.2022, as per Information Bulletin of AIAPGET, 2022, point no. 5.3. The candidate should be registered with the State Ayurvedic Council/NCISM New Delhi. All candidates (General/SC/D-SC/BC-A/BC-B/Benchmark disabilities/EWS/ESM/FF) desirous of seeking admissions in any category of seats should fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria/qualifications/qualifying criteria as prescribed in the information bulletin for AIAPGET-2022 issued by NTA for the Academic year 2022-23 and as per regulations of NCISM issued from time to time. <p>The candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks (as specified in AIAPGET-2022) shall not be eligible for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses.</p> <p>Note: The candidate shall have to bring, in original, all the relevant certificates/ documents at the time of document verification without which admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda) Courses shall not be granted. Attested photocopies of certificates/documents will not be considered valid for the purpose of counseling and the seat allocated to them online shall be cancelled.</p>
8.	<p>A student who is already admitted to any PG Courses including PG Diploma course in any Institution is not eligible to apply till the completion of the course. An undertaking to this effect shall be given by the candidate. Concealment of facts would invite disqualification without assigning any reason.</p>
9.	<p>After commencement of PG courses if a candidate having joined the Institute but leaves the course after the three days prior to the last date of admission as prescribed by NCISM New Delhi, (e.g. 18.10.2022 as prescribed by NCISM i.e. on/after 15.10.2022), then:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> He/She will be debarred for next three years from applying for admission to any PG Course in the State. He/She will have to pay the Bond Money of Rs. 7,50,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) for PG Course for which Bond shall be executed at the time of admission by the Institute. <p>The candidates at the time of admission will be required to execute a bond with two sureties (on non-judicial stamp duly attested by 1st Class magistrate that he /she will not leave the course before completion. In case, any one leaves the course midway, he/she will pay Rs. 7,50,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) to Institution concerned. The student shall also have to return the whole amount of stipend/emoluments paid to him/her in advance. This rule shall not be applicable in the condition of death or certified serious illness (by the Medical Board of PGIMS, Rohtak or equivalent) of the candidate. The Institution reserves the right to recover such money from the defaulters as per due procedure and there after the candidates will also be debarred for admission to any PG Course for next 3 years. The Performa of the agreement is given in Annexure – X.</p>

10.	Procedure for Admission to State Quota seats in Participating College(s) (Haryana)		
(i)	The admissions under above stated categories among all the registered candidates on the admission web portal will be made online on the basis of Haryana State Merit list prepared on the basis of AIAPGET-2022.		
(ii)	The schedule of document verification/admissions and start of classes shall be in conformity with the schedule laid down by NCISM/Ministry of AYUSH, State Government and Government of India.		
(iii)	Candidates applying on the basis of AIAPGET-2022 should fulfill the eligibility criteria for being granted admissions as fixed under AIAPGET-2022.		
(iv)	In case of a tie between two or more candidates having equal marks, the inter-se ranking of such candidates will be based on AIAPGET-2022 rank.		
(v)	The choice of the college/course/specialty shall be filled by the candidate on the online web portal. The choices of college/course/specialty in the order of preferences given by the candidate will be considered final.		
(vi)	<p>Before filling up of the college/course/specialty read these points clearly –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) Before filling the college/course/specialty first segregate the Govt. and Private Ayurvedic Colleges. ii) Check the availability of specialty in particular college. iii) Check the availability of stipend. iv) Check their tuition fees. v) Check the place of the Institute. vi) You need not have to fill all the college/course/specialty. Only filling of one choice is mandatory. Rest all can be filled as per your preference. 		
(vii)	The allotment of the college/course/specialty shall be made strictly as per merit prepared/drawn on the basis of merit of AIAPGET-2022 in case of in-service candidates and the choice/preference of the college/course/specialty filled up by the candidate on the online portal shall be taken as final.		
(viii)	However, the online counseling result shall be provisional and final confirmation of seats and allotment of college/course/specialty will be done by Admission Committee after physical verification of eligibility and original documents by the Admission Committee of the participating college/institute.		
(ix)	<p>The candidates who have been provisionally allocated seat will have to appear in person for document verification (with all original documents and two sets of self-attested Photostat copies) before the Admission Committee of the allotted college/institute. The detailed schedule will be announced later on and the candidates are required to regularly visit the website as stated above for updates.</p> <p>The provisional allocation of the seat online shall give no legal right to the candidate for the said seat and the seat shall be confirmed only after document verification with in the specific time period as notified. The Admission Committee reserves the right to cancel the provisional allocation of seat allotted to a candidate in case of incomplete/invalid documents.</p>

(xi)	The Admission Committee will be responsible for taking decision for admission related matters		

like-supervision of admission & conduct of counseling, allocation of seats etc. in accordance with existing rules and regulation. Further, the admission Committee is empowered to take decision in all admission related disputes.

Note:

- I. The Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Department of Health & AYUSH, will be the final Appellate Authority in all admissions related disputes and his decision shall be the final.
- II. Final number of seats in each college/course/specialty will be available on the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra (www.skau.ac.in).
- III. In case there is vacancy after the first round of counseling due to any reason, such seats will be filled up during the second round of counseling.
 - a.) Fresh registration shall be allowed for participating in the second round. Fresh candidates will have to register themselves on the admission web portal. The candidates are advised to regularly visit the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra-www.skau.ac.in and the admission web portal for updates.
 - b.) The candidates, who have already registered themselves for first round and wish to participate in the second round, shall not be required to register again. However, they shall have to give their willingness/option to participate in the second round of online counseling by **submitting the previous online form again** with the same registration number, **the security fee and change of choices if any**.
 - c.) The candidate who wish to participate in the 2nd round of PG Counseling shall be required to submit Security Fee of Rs. 10,000/- {Rs. 5,000/- for SC/DSC/BC/EWS/ESM/FF/PwD* of Haryana State (*if applicable)}, at the time of form filling/willingness or preference filling online. The fresh candidates will also have to submit registration fee as per Notification of P.G. Courses. If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the 2nd round of Counseling. This amount shall be later adjusted in the fee of first year course and refunded in case no seat is allotted.
 - d.) The candidate who have been allotted seat in the first round shall have a right to retain already allotted seat and this shall be changed only if he/she gets an updated and opted seat during second round. However, the candidates who wish to participate in the 2nd round of online counseling will have to submit their preferences afresh again. Candidates, who have been allotted, seat in first round should give the fresh choices in order of preferences for the College/Course/Specialty in which they wish to upgrade themselves.
 - e.) The candidates who are allotted seats in the 2nd round of counseling but do not join or leave after joining, their security fee submitted shall stand forfeited, however they will be eligible to participate in the 3rd /mop-up round.
 - f.) If the seats still remain vacant even after the two rounds of counseling, then left over seats will be filled up via 3rd/Mop-Up Round as per direction of Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India/NCISM/State Government and as per SKAU, Kurukshetra notified Schedule.
 - g.) Fresh registration shall be allowed for participating in the 3rd/Mop-up round. Fresh candidates will have to register themselves on the admission web portal. The candidates are advised to regularly visit the website of Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra- www.skau.ac.in and the admission web portal for updates.
 - h.) The candidates who join the seat allotted to them during both round of counseling shall not be eligible to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up Round. However such candidates can participate in the 3rd/Mop-up Round only after leaving the joined seats.
 - i.) The candidates, who have already registered themselves in previous rounds and have not been allotted any seat and wish to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up round, shall not be required to register again. However, they shall have to give their willingness/option to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up round of online counseling by submitting the previous online form again with the same registration number and the security fee.

- j.) The candidate who wish to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up round of PG counseling shall be required to submit Security Fee of Rs. 20,000/- {Rs. 10,000/- for SC/DSC/BC/EWS/ESM/FF/PwD* of Haryana State (*if applicable)}, at the time of form filling/ willingness or preference filling online. The fresh candidates will also have to submit registration fee as per Notification of P.G. Courses. If a candidate does not deposit the requisite amount then he/she shall not be eligible to participate in the 3rd/Mop-up round of counseling. This amount shall be later adjusted in the fee of first year course and refunded in case no seat is allotted.
- k.) If the seats remain vacant even after 3rd/Mop-up Round of Counseling then left-over seats will be filled up by clearing the waiting list, if the cut-off date will not be extended by Ministry of AYUSH/CCIM, New Delhi.
- l.) All Govt. of Haryana in-service candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria of AIAPGET-2022 and have valid NOC issued by competent authority shall be eligible for counseling. Any in-service candidate without valid NOC shall not be eligible for counseling to PG for academic session 2022-23. The in-service candidates will have to bring the original NOC issued by competent authority at the time of document verification in front of Admission Committee at Shri Krishna AYUSH University, Kurukshetra, failing which they will not be eligible for counseling.

IV. Shifting to other college/subject/specialty will be allowed only in 2nd round of counseling and not thereafter.

V. The Registration cum Counseling fee shall be as under: (Non-Refundable)

- 1) Rs. 2,000/- for Unreserved Category.
- 2) Rs. 500/- for SC/D-SC/BC/EWS/FF/ESM (All reserved) Category of Haryana.
- 3) Rs. 500/- for Physically Handicap (PwD).
- 4) Rs. 2,000/- for all Reserved Category of Other states of India not included in 2) & 3)
- 5) Rs. 10,000/- for NRI Category.

The candidates are required to regularly visit the website as stated above for updates.

b) The fee shall be payable on annual basis and the college shall not ask the candidates to deposit fee for the entire course in advance.

c) In case of request for withdrawal of admission by a candidate the fee shall be refundable to the candidate, only if the request is made in person along with original receipt of fee deposition and no request shall be entertained through e-mail. The candidate will have to make the request at least 03 days prior to the last date prescribed for admission to MD/MS (Ayurveda).

12. **Admission to NRI Category (NRIs/PIOs/OCIs/Foreign Nationals)**

All admissions under NRI category seats shall be as per merit of AIAPGET-2022. Person of Indian Origin (PIO), Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) and Foreign Nationals who are AIAPGET qualified can also apply under the NRI category, however for admission under NRI quota Foreign Nationals shall be considered only for any vacant seat left after exhausting the list of NRIs/PIOs/OCIs.

Preference of admission shall be as given below:-

- (i) Actual NRIs/PIOs/OCIs Candidates who originally belonged to the State of Haryana (for the colleges situated in the State of Haryana) & UT Chandigarh (for only Shri Dhanwantry Ayurvedic College, Chandigarh) respectively as the case may be.
- (ii) Children of NRIs/PIOs/OCIs who originally belonged to State of Haryana (for the colleges situated in the State of Haryana) & UT Chandigarh (for only Shri Dhanwantry Ayurvedic

	<p>College, Chandigarh) respectively as the case may be.</p> <p>(iii) Actual NRIs/PIOs/OCIs Candidates who originally belonged to an Indian State or Union Territories other than Haryana & UT Chandigarh respectively as the case may be.</p> <p>(iv) Children of NRIs/PIOs/OCIs who originally belonged to an Indian State or Union Territories other than Haryana & UT Chandigarh respectively as the case may be.</p> <p>(v)</p> <p>a) If the first-degree relation of the student in NRI and residing abroad ordinarily, then in such circumstances also, quo this year, should be considered eligible. Subject: - Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections in Direct recruitment in Civil posts and services as well as in admissions in Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions in the State of Haryana.

I am directed to inform that government of India has notified “THE CONSTITUTION (ONE HUNDRED AND THIRD AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019” On 12th January, 2019 amending Article 15 & 16, which are now read as under: -

Amendment of article 15

In Article 15 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted namely: -

‘(6) Nothing in this article or sub-clauses (g) of clause (1) of article 19 or clause (2) of article 29 shall prevent the State from making, -

- a). Any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5); and
- b). Any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5); in so far as such special provisions relate to their admission to educational institutions including private educational institutions, whether aided or unaided by the State, other than the minority educational institutions referred to in clause(1) of article 30, which in the case of reservation would be in addition to the existing reservations and subject to a maximum of ten per cent of the total seats in each category.

Explanation- For the purposes of this article and article 16, “economically weaker sections” shall be such as may be notified by the State from time to time on the basis of family income and other indicators of economic disadvantage.’

Amendment of article 16

In Article 16 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted, namely: -

“(6) Nothing in this article shall prevent the State from making any provision for the reservation of appointment or posts in favour of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clause (4), in addition to the existing reservation and subject to a maximum of ten cent of the posts in each category”.

In the wake of above enabling provisions, State Government has considered the matter and decided to provide benefits of reservation on a preferential basis in Civil Posts in all the Departments/Boards/Corporations/Local Bodies and in Admissions to Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions to those Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B).

2. QUANTUM OF RESERVATION:

The persons belong to EWSs who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for scheduled Castes, Backward Classes (Block – A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) shall get 10% reservation in direct recruitment to Group A, B, C and D posts in the Departments/Boards/Corporations/Local Bodies of Government of Haryana and also in admission to Government/Government Aided Educational Institutions in the State of Haryana.

3. EFFECTING RESERVATION-ROSTER POINT:

3.1 Direct recruitment in case of Group-A & B

Roster point No. 11-20-30-40-51-60-70-80-90 and 99

3.2 Direct recruitment in case of Group-C & D

Roster point No. 4-14-24-34-43-53-66-76-82 and 94

3.3 Where in any recruitment year any vacancy earmarked for EWS cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies for that particular recruitment year shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog and will be filled from unreserved category.

3.4 Persons belonging to EWS selected against the quota for persons with benchmark disabilities/ex-servicemen shall be placed against the roster points earmarked for EWS.

4. CRITERIA OF INCOME & ASSETS:

4.1 Persons who are not covered under the exiting scheme of reservation for Scheduled Caste, Backward Classes (Block-A) and Backward Classes (Block-B) and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 6.00 lakh (Rupees six lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e., salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application.

4.2 Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income: -

- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;
- iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities.
- v. Total immovable assets owned are valued at Rs. One Crore or more.

4.3 The property held by a “Family” in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

4.4 The term “Family” for this purpose will include the person who applies for benefit of reservation, his/her parents, spouse as well as children and siblings below the age of 18 years.

5. INCOME AND ASSET CERTIFICATE ISSUING AUTHORITY AND VERIFICATION OF CERTIFICATE:

5.1 The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent Authority. The competent Authority for EWS Income and Asset Certificate shall be Tehsildar of the area where the applicant normally resides.

5.2 The prescribed format for EWS income and Asset Certificate shall be as provided at Annexure-I.

5.3 The Officer who issues the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the State.

5.4 The crucial date for submitting Income and Asset Certificate by the candidate may be treated as the closing date for receipt of application for the post, except in cases where crucial date is fixed otherwise.

- 5.5 The appointing authorities should, in the offer of appointment to the candidates claiming to be belonging to EWS, include the following clause: -

“The appointment is provisional and is subject to the income and asset certificate being verified through the proper channels and if the verification reveals that the claim to belong to EWS is fake/false the services will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reasons and provisions of the Indian Penal Code for production of fake/false certificate.”

The appointing authority should verify the veracity of the Income and asset certificate submitted by the candidate through the certificate issuing authority.

- 5.6 Instructions referred to above should be strictly followed so that it may not be possible for an unscrupulous person to secure employment on the basis of a false claim and if any person gets an appointment on the basis of such false claim, her/his services shall be terminated and penal action shall also be invoked.

6. **ADJUSTMENT AGAINST UNRESERVED VACANCIES:**

A person belonging to EWS cannot be denied the right to compete for appointment against an unreserved vacancy. Persons belonging to EWS who are selected on the basis of merit and not on account of reservation are not to be counted towards the quota meant for reservation.

7. The above scheme of reservation will be effective in respect of all direct recruitment vacancies to be notified on or after 01.02.2019.

Copy of letter No.62/17/95-6 GSI Dated, Chandigarh, the 3rd October, 1996 received from the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana addressed to All Heads of Departments, Commissioners Ambala, Rohtak, Gurugram and Hisar Divisions, All Deputy Commissioners and all Sub Divisional Officers (Civil) in Haryana, The Registrar, Punjab and Haryana High Court and all District and Session Judges in Haryana.

Subject: "Bonafide residents of Haryana - Guidelines regarding".

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Govt. letters noted in the margin in the subject noted above vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for the purpose of admission to educational institution (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-1421, wherein it has been held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Resident' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government and it has been decided to revise the Government instructions. Henceforth, the following categories of persons would be eligible for the grant of Resident Certificate:-

- i) Candidates, who have passed the examination qualifying there for selection in an institution from a school/college in Haryana.
- ii) Children / Wards (if parents are not living) / Dependents: -
 - (a) Of the regular employees of Haryana State posted in or outside Haryana State or working on deputation;
 - (b) Of the regular employees of the statutory bodies/ corporations established by or under an act of the State of Haryana who are posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana or outside Haryana"
 - (c) Of the regular employees of the Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of the Haryana Government;
- iii) Children /wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons who after retirement have permanently settled in Haryana and draw their pensions from the treasuries situated in the State of Haryana.
- iv) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of pensioners of Haryana Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Haryana or he has settled after retirement in or outside Haryana;
- v) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons, who have permanent home in Haryana and include persons who have been residing in Haryana for a period of not less than 15 years or who have permanent home in Haryana but on account of their occupation they are living outside Haryana;
- vi) The wives of such persons who are bonafide residents of Haryana irrespective of the fact that they had belonged to any other State before marriage;
- vii) Persons who were born in Haryana and produce a certificate to that effect; provided that the parents/ guardians (if parents are not living) of persons belonging to any one of the above mentioned categories are:
 - a) Citizen of India;
 - b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents have not obtained the benefit of Resident in any other State.

2. All candidates claiming to be bonafide residents of Haryana should produce a Haryana Resident Certificate signed by the District Magistrate/General Assistant to Deputy Commissioner or Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) of the District/Sub-Divisions to which the candidates belong. Resident Certificates in respect of elsewhere or in respect of the Children/Wards/Dependents of Haryana Govt, employees who are posted at Chandigarh, Delhi or elsewhere or in respect of Children /Wards/ Dependents of pensioners of Haryana Govt. or in respect of the Children/ Wards/ Department of the employees of the Government of India posted at Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of Haryana Government, or in respect of Children/ Wards/ Dependents of the employees and retirees of the Statutory Bodies/Corporations of Haryana established by or under an Act of the State of Haryana or a Central Act and located at Chandigarh, Haryana or outside Haryana, should be by their respective heads of Departments.

3. Candidates seeking admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions) located in Haryana may not be required to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the examination from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose, a certificate of the principal/Headmaster from concerned institution where the children/wards studied last school be considered sufficient. The Principal/Headmaster of the institution shall be competent to issue such certificate, which should be sufficient.

4. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of claim that he belongs to the State of Haryana but at any subsequent time is discovered that his claim was false, the student shall be removed from the institution, all fees and other dues paid up to the date of such removal shall be confiscated" The Principal/ Headmaster may take such other action against the student and his/her parents/guardians as he may deem proper in the circumstances of any particular case,
5. For the purpose of uniformity for issuing certificate of Residence in the case of various categories to be issued by the competent authorities, performas have been prescribed which are enclosed here with,

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government letters Nos. 62117195-2G.S.III, dated 03.10.96, No. 22151/93-3G.S.III, dated 12.8.93 and even No. dated 14.10.97 on the subject noted above wherein instructions regarding the caste certificates (SC/BC/OBC), and Resident certificate have been issued.

2. The policy has been reviewed keeping in view the various courts judgements and the hardships caused to the individuals in obtaining above quoted certificates. Government is of the view that the procedure be institutionalized by delegating powers at proper level for ensuring speedy disposal of work without any harassment or exploitation, The present modification of the policy also aims at simplifying the procedure for obtaining certificate by an individual falling under the reserved categories.
3. The matter has also been reconsidered in depth by the State Government in view of the problems being faced by the Government employees in obtaining these certificates. With a view to improve the existing system in issuing various certificates, it has been decided by the Government that henceforth Circle Revenue Officers (Tehsildar, Naib-Tehsildar-cum-Executive Magistrate) concerned will be authorized to issue Resident as well as Caste Certificates (SC/BC/OBC) after getting the verification done through the subordinate revenue staff in case of applicants residing in the rural area and through the Executive Officer/Secretary of the concerned Municipal Committee/Municipal Council/Municipal Corporation concerned in case of applicants residing in urban area. It has further been decided that in case of Haryana Government employees serving in the offices located at Chandigarh/Panchkula and residing at Chandigarh/Panchkula, the Resident certificates and caste certificate to SC/BC employees and for their children, may be issued by their respective Heads of Departments also.
4. The validity of Resident Certificate issued by the competent authority shall be as long as the holder of this certificate maintains his residential address in Haryana State.
5. SC certificate once issued shall be valid as long as the caste is not removed from the Schedule of the Constitution and BC certificate shall be valid for life from the date of issue of the certificate or till the applicant does not fall into creamy layer category as defined from time to time. The applicant applying for BC certificate would also submit a self-declaration on simple paper that he does not fall under creamy layer category. The format for this declaration is given at Annexure 'A' However, if the certificate has been obtained by fraud or misrepresentation or concealment of facts or by some other means, the said certificate shall be declared as invalid/ and benefit taken by the applicant will be withdrawn and a criminal case shall be registered against the applicant misrepresenting the facts as well as against the guilty officers/officials, if any. In addition, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana is being, directed to finalize the modalities and procedure to constitute the Scrutiny Committee.
6. The files relating to Caste and Resident certificate shall be retained for 10 years and Register shall be retained permanently, The performa of the application form, Register and SC/BC certificates prescribed by the Government shall be followed by all the Departments/Institutions in letter and spirit as it has come to the notice of the Govt. that some Departments/institutions demand such certificates in performa which are at variance with the performa in which these certificates are being issued by the competent authorities (Tehsildar / NaibTehsildar/HODs). It is, therefore, decided that the Departments/institutions shall accept these certificates only in the performa in which these are being issued by the competent authorities which have been prescribed by the Govt. itself (copy enclosed).
7. To make institutional arrangements, it has also been decided that in future the Resident and Caste certificates will be issued to all the students studying in class 5th every year as per the time schedule given below:-
 - i. filling of application form by the parents/students. 1st Nov- 10th Nov. every year.
 - ii. Verification by:
 - (a) Sarpanch/ Namberdar in case of rural areas and Municipal Councillors in case of urban areas.

- (b) Verification by Patwari in case of rural areas /EO/Secy.(MC) any other officer/official authorized by the local body for the purpose in case of urban areas. Upto 30th November every year.
- (c) Head Teacher/Head Master Upto 15th Dec.
- iii Forwarding of application to CRO by Head Teacher/Head Master 31st Dec. Verification & issue of certificate by CRO Upto 31st January every year
8. All application forms of a particular School may be sent to the Tehsildar /NaibTehsildar concerned preferably at one go so that the certificates are issued and sent back to the Head masters of Government Schools/Private Schools for distribution to the concerned students. The Head Teacher/Head Master shall be responsible for getting the application forms filled and files prepared of all the students presently studying in Class-VIII to XII will be issued these certificates during the months of January, 2004 to March, 2004. The schedule will be finalized by the concerned Deputy Commissioner in this regard.
9. It has been further decided that in case of SC/BC students claiming benefit under various welfare schemes upto Class IX, the benefits will be given by the Head Master/Head Teacher after getting the verification done from Sarpanch/ Namberdar/MC and a caste certificate issued by the CRO (Tehsildar/ NaibTehsildar) may not be demanded for this purpose by the School authorities.
10. The matter regarding issue of income certificate to the students for claiming various benefits in educational institutions has been considered and it has been decided that in future the income certificate for educational purpose will be issued by the CRO (Tehsildar/NaibTehsildar concerned) and income certificate for other purposes by the SDO concerned taking into account income of the applicant from various sources including agriculture, trade, profession, salary etc. The verification will be got done through the subordinate revenue staff in case of applicants residing in rural areas and through the Executive Officers/Secretary of the concerned Municipal Committee/Council/Municipal Corporation in case of applicants residing in urban areas.
11. It has also been brought to the notice of the Government that when posts are advertised, fairly large number of candidates applies for such posts and Haryana Public Service Commission/Haryana Staff Selection Commission /Department demand attested copies of Resident/Caste certificates and other documents from the candidates. This creates not only financial problems for the unemployed youths but also increases the work load in the offices. Similar is the position in case of admission to educational/professional Engineering institutions. To give relief to the public, it has been decided that at the time of applying for job or for admission in educational institutions including technical/professional institutions etc. self-attested photo copy of the certificate about the residence and caste status shall be sufficient and at the time of final interview/selection, original papers including castes and Resident certificate issued by the competent authorities may be obtained/examined/inspected by the concerned departments/institutions and attested copies thereof be kept in record. The fact may also be cross checked/ verified at the time of verification of the antecedents of the applicants before he/she joins the Government service. Similar practice will be followed for degrees/mark sheets/other certificates of academic qualifications. Necessary action to amend/revise the application form in this regard shall be taken by Haryana Public Service Commission/ Haryana Staff Selection Commission/ Head of the Departments Universities etc. at their own level under intimation to the Government.
- These instructions may be brought to the knowledge of all for strict compliance.


